Many existing failing & underperforming on-lot septic systems in the Village


Poorly drained soils, shallow bedrock & small lots render replacement systems impossible

New housing needed to save the school & Town


Rural Edge Housing & Community

Town-owned WW needed to preserve public health & the environment




What is a Community Wastewater Disposal System?

Proposed Community Wastewater Disposal System


