## July 10-11, 2023 Severe Storm – by the numbers:

- A) DAMAGE TO TOWN ROADS (estimate): \$2.3 million
- B) FEDERAL REIMBURSEMENTS RECEIVED BY TOWN AS OF 2/25/25: \$1,825,392
  - This includes \$518k in funding for specific road improvements to be completed in 2025 (cash in hand but is spoken for)
- C) ADDITIONAL STATE & FEDERAL REIMBURSEMENTS EXPECTED TO BE RECEIVED IN 2025: \$388,811
- D) THE TOWN'S SHARE OF ALL 2023 FLOOD EXPENSES (2.2%): \$51,221
- E) FUNDS BORROWED BY TOWN TO PAY FOR FLOOD REPAIRS: \$1,000,000.
  - The town's two notes were paid back in full in February, 2025 using FEMA reimbursements.
  - FEMA is covering most of the interest costs of these notes.
- **F)** MAJOR OUTSTANDING PROJECT FROM 2023: The bridge replacement on Shadow Lake Rd. is estimated to cost \$350,000. As with other 2023 flood costs the Feds will cover 90% and the State will cover \$7.8%.
