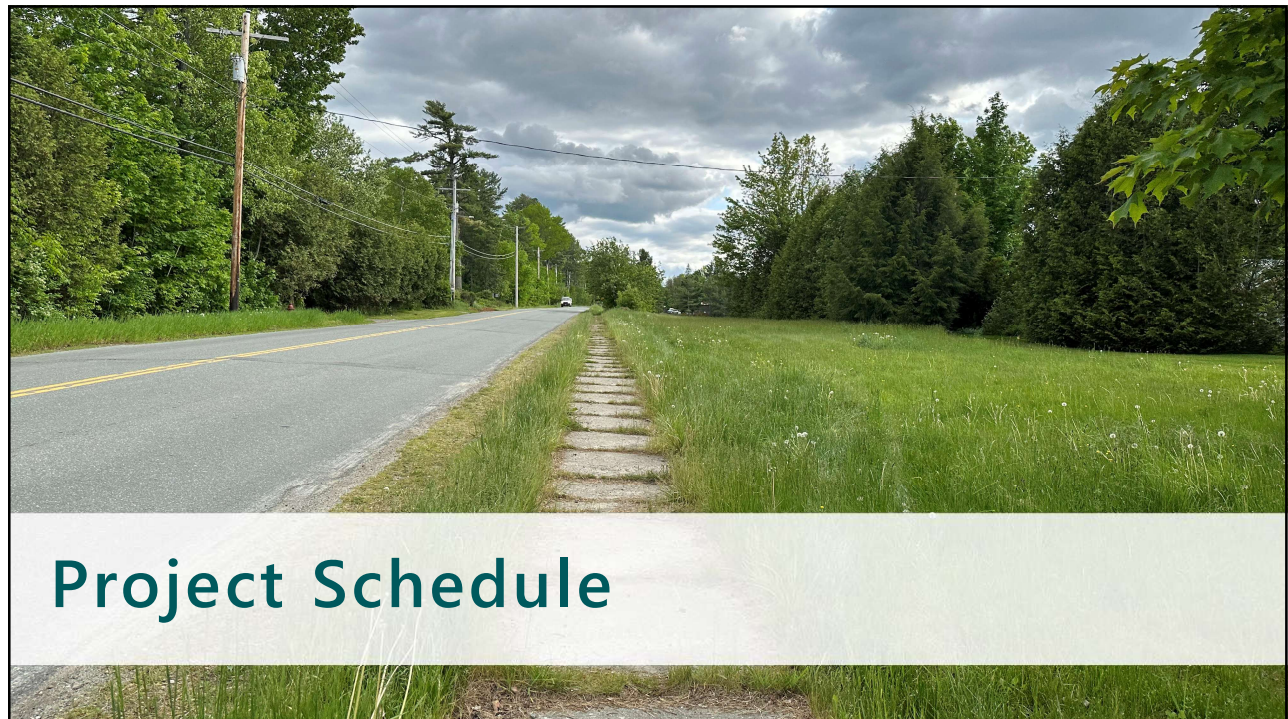

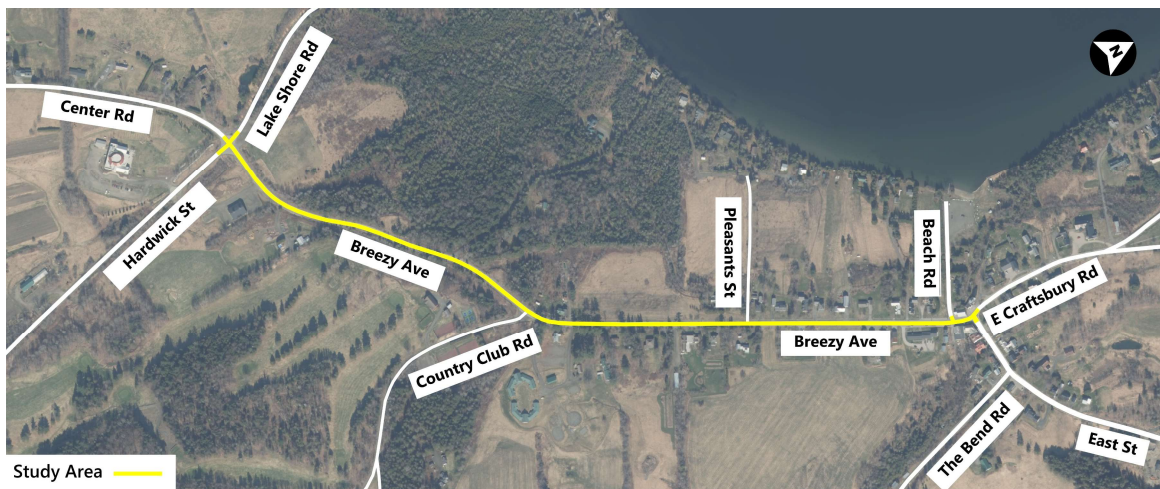

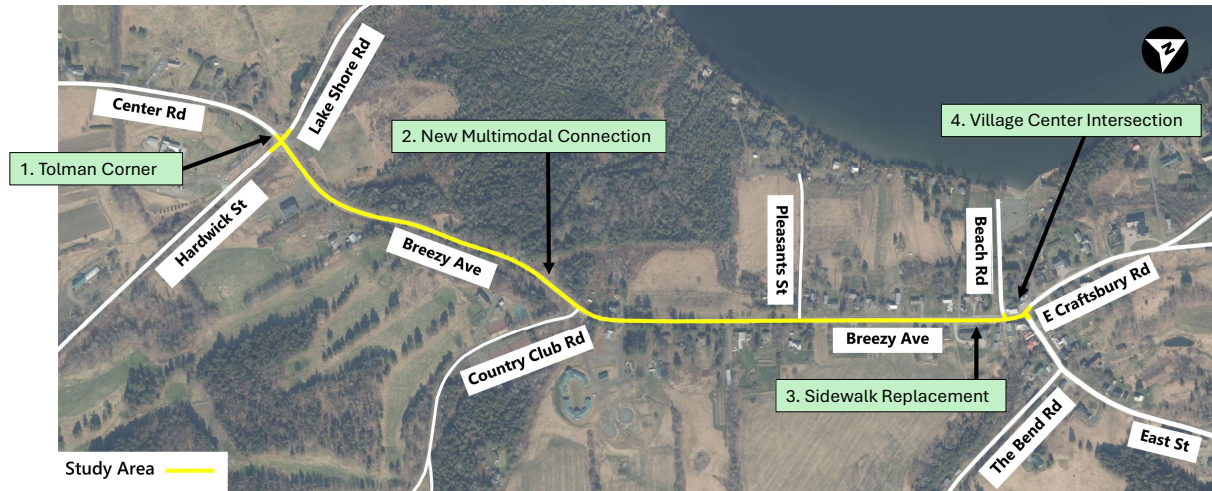

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This Scoping Study Will...

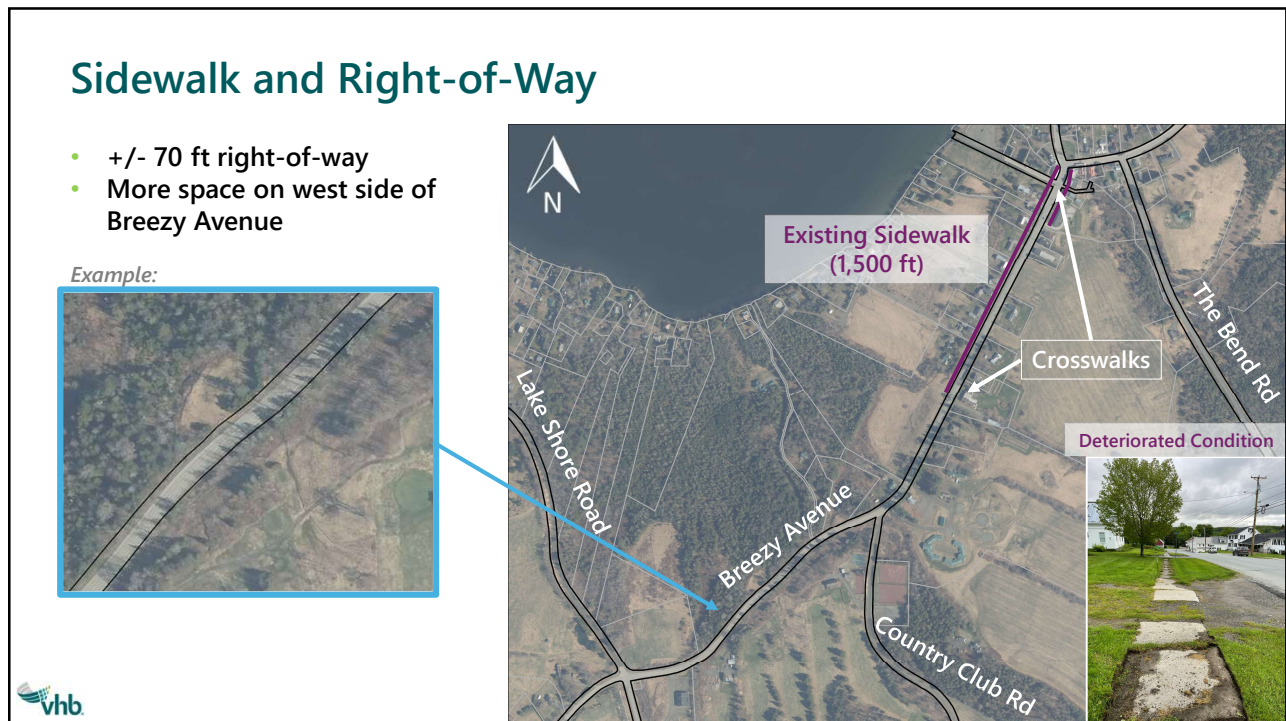
- Develop and evaluate alternatives for multimodal connectivity along Breezy Avenue
- Investigate opportunities to manage speeds, improve crossings, and control traffic at Tolman Corner and the Willey's Store intersections
- Complete the critical planning step needed before the project moves into engineering design
- Position Greensboro for future grant funding



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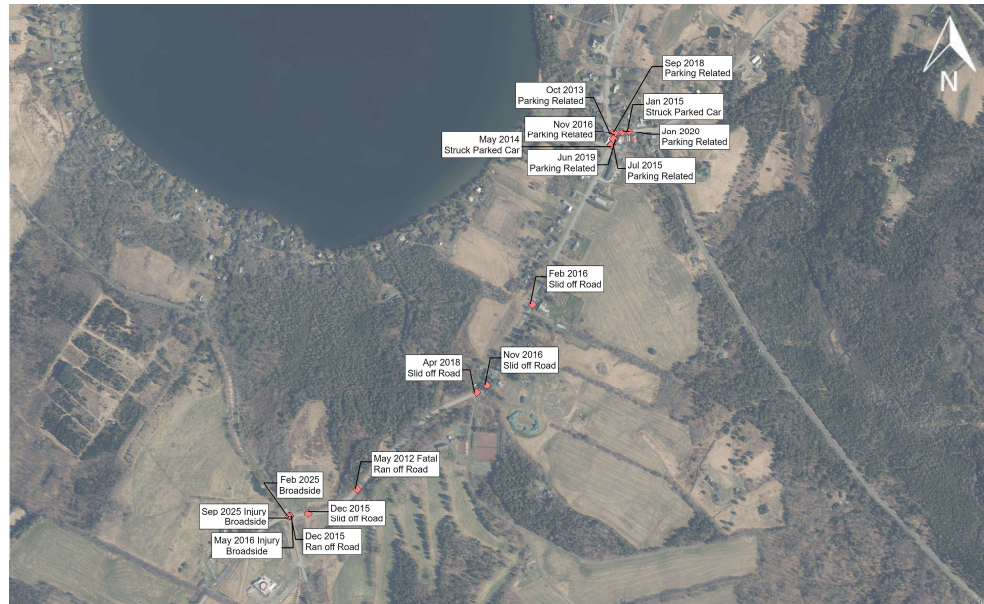
Crash History (2015-present)

- 17 crashes
- 1 fatality
- No pedestrian/bicycle crashes

Traffic

- Average: 1,409 vehicles/day
- Peak* (July): 1,725 vehicles/day
- Low (January): 1,081 vehicles/day

* Fridays in July: 1,990



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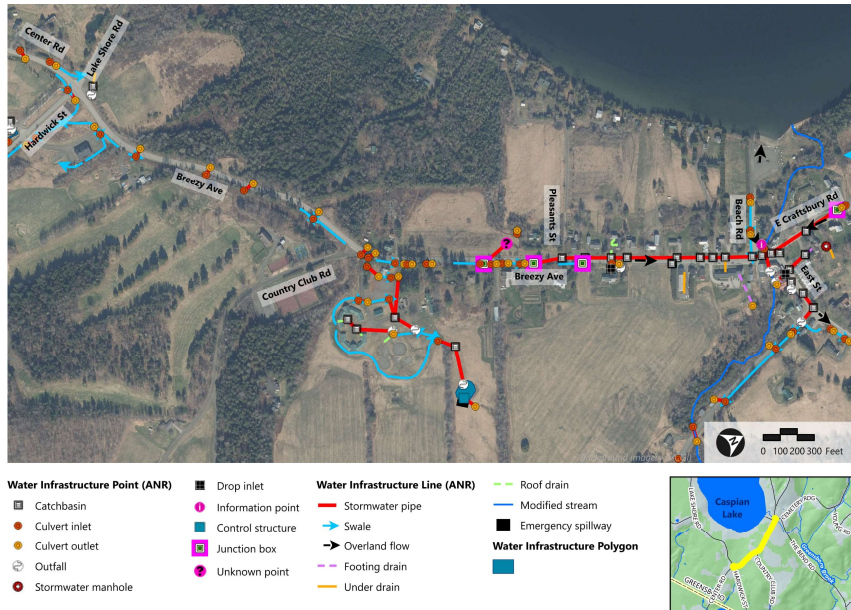
Culverts

- Most are for driveways



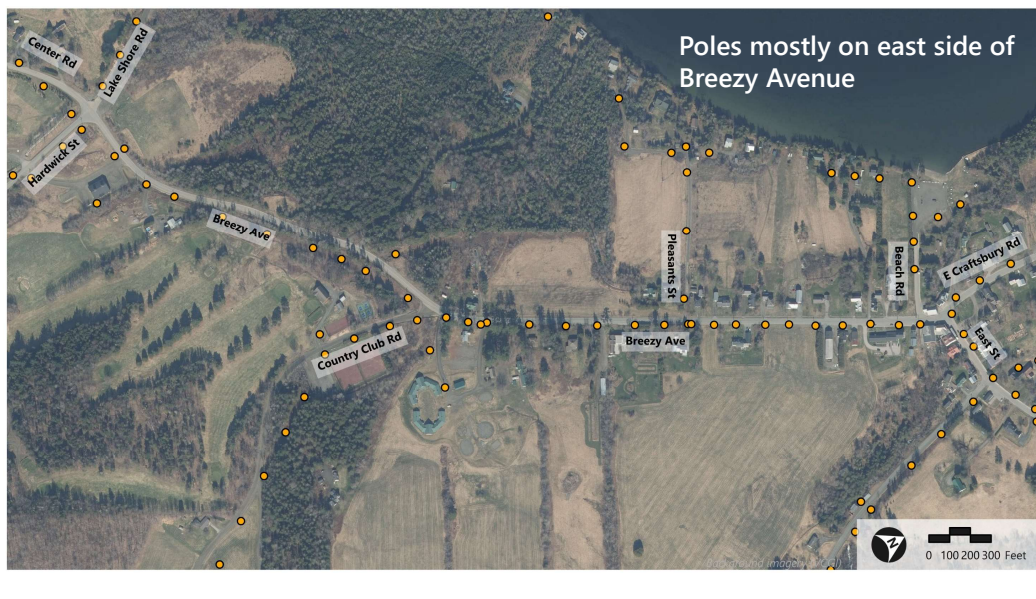
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Infrastructure – Water Utilities



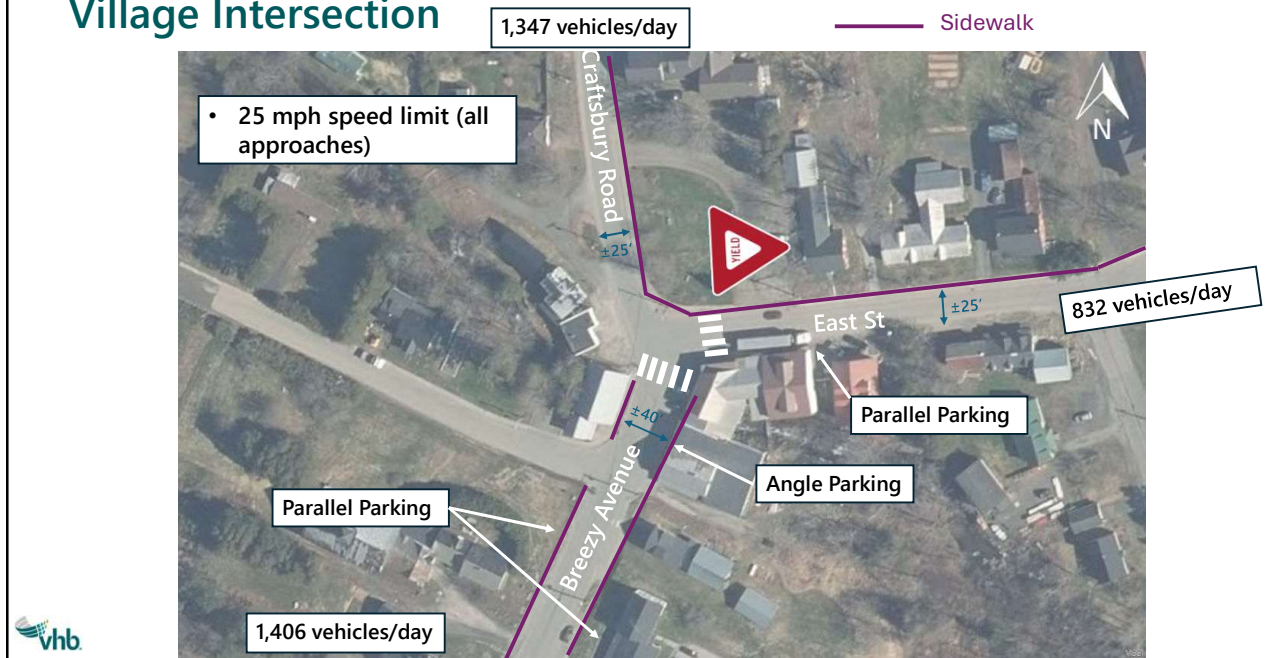
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Infrastructure – Hardwick Electric Department



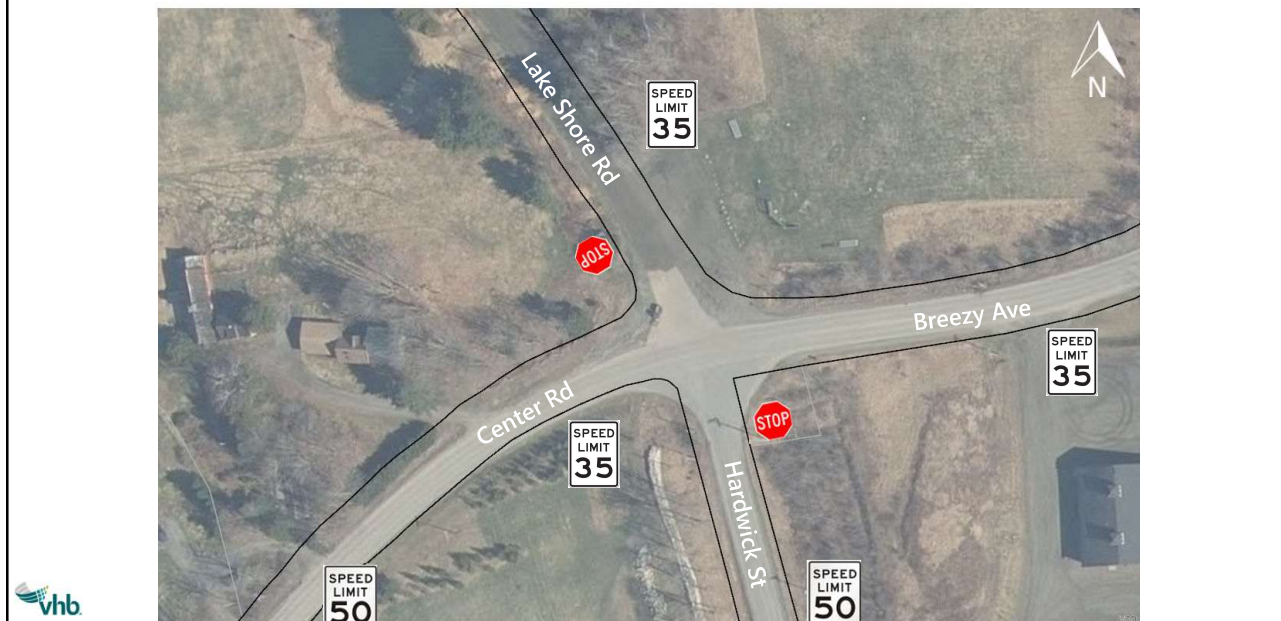
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Village Intersection



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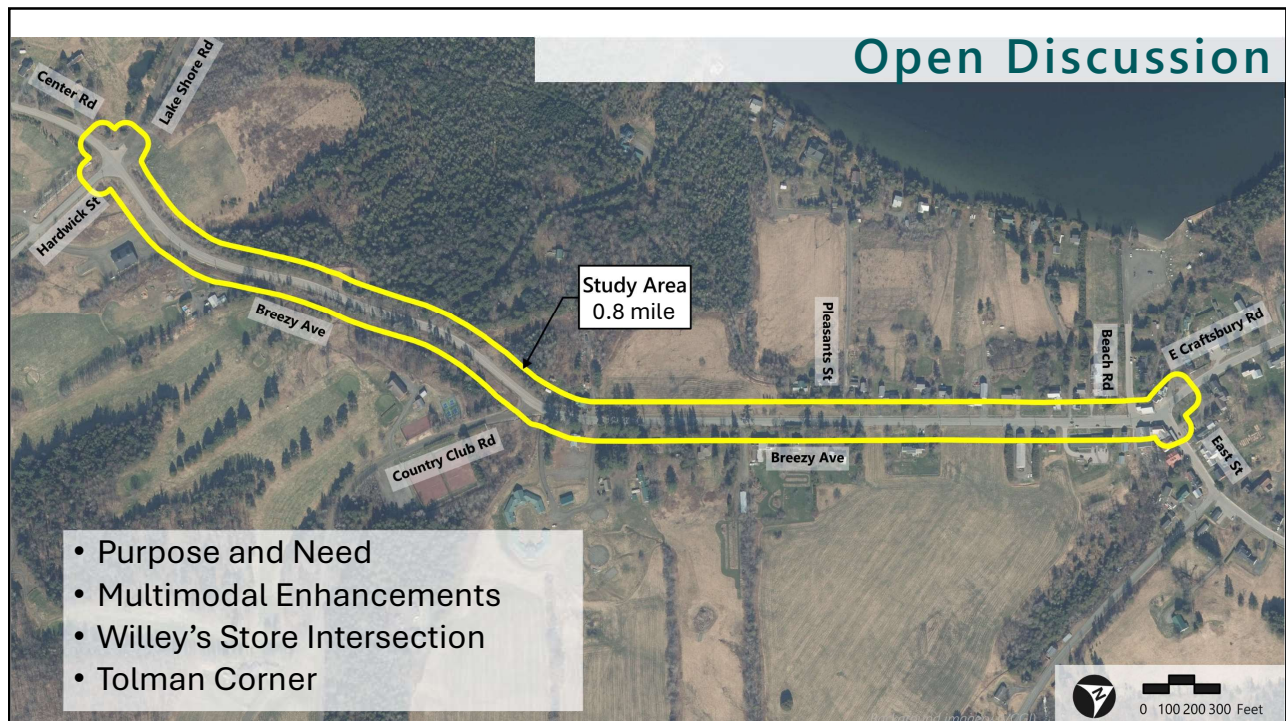
