New Business:

- the 3 granite slabs by the dam- Hardwick Electric waiting for 2 years for VT Department of Natural Resources to give OK to place in the dam

- Extending the parking lot to the grass area in the back was nixed

- the plaque for the granite benches was admired and given to Earl to apply

- Mike Sullivan- Hardwick Electric commissioners, representing the rate payers and owners, ultimately manage the beach real estate

- 2 Replacement silver maple trees were planted 5/17/22 by Hillcrest nursery- Linda and Ila will water daily for one month

- Discussion on the recent accident in the parking lot about considering closing the beach after the 11PM curfew- all agreed to talk with Orleans

County Sheriff's Department about options for beach safety and fire department access

- The beach entrance sign has been down, and Earl has asked the Town Road crew to repair and reset it

- The boat wash sign is gone- Ila will ask Stu Arnold of the Greensboro Association about replacing it

- John will talk to John Mackin to explain the water bill

- The opening in the front benches for access to the dam and fire department was discussed, because there is no barrier, and cars are driving through

it- Opie will talk to Mike Sullivan

- The swim program will run from July 18 through the 22nd. Teach America to Swim will be conducting lessons

- New swimming area buoy markers are being made by Bob Parrish (who has taken them in and out for years), and he will install soon

## Budget:

- Usually \$7000/year with Greensboro and Hardwick each contributing \$3300 and the Greensboro Association \$1000

- There is a \$9000 Capital account

- For FY22, \$970 remains in beach maintenance and \$1250 for beach projects

- \$1650 is budgeted in FY23 for beach maintenance and \$1650 for beach projects
