

Minutes—Greensboro Recreation Committee, 3/23/26, Greensboro Town Hall

In attendance were MacNeil, Jennifer Ranz, Mike Malik, Ila Hunt, Dede Stabler (via Google Meet), and David Kelley.

There being no incumbent officers on the Committee, the meeting was called to order at 4:00 P.M. by MacNeil as Chair of the Greensboro Select Board.

The first order of business was to elect officers. Jennifer Ranz was elected chairperson, Dede Stabler was elected vice chair. David Kelley was elected clerk.

No one was certain as to how much money was in the Rec Committee's budget. Dave Kelley said he would get that number.

There was discussion of the swim program. The committee expressed gratitude for Ila's willingness to see the program through for this year. It was also decided to ask the Select Board to consider merging the swim program with the Rec Committee for next year. David said he will distribute informational flyers for the swim program to Hazen.

There was next a discussion of trying to get younger people on the committee. Dave Kelley said he would reach out to Jay Modry and John and Emily Stone. Nick Wright and Celeste were people who were also mentioned as possible members who we should reach out to.

The committee then went on to discuss programs that the Rec Committee should or may need to coordinate in the future. Among the topics discussed were the skating rink, a fishing program. There was additional discussion of pickleball and the players finding a good place to play. The Caspian Run and the Tour de Greensboro was mentioned as important past events. It appears that past organizers of some of these events are stepping down, and again we need new volunteers.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:30.
