

From the June 27th (2025) meeting with Lynnette Claudon to see how we may 1) use remaining funds, 2) proceed with pursuing a village wastewater system:

A) Short answer is that we may use the \$100k remaining funds to work with Hoyle Tanner

B) Greensboro will need to amend the town's EPA grant agreement

C) Hoyle Tanner's Engineering Services Agreement needs to include two types of tests:

- 1) 1 meter square - surface profile for sensitive archeological significance,
- 2) backhoe test pit(s) - large area for: soil scientists work, hydrological work, and to answer if the soil matches the mapping and they WW needs

Lynnette's advice was:

- 1) Use hand auger testing before archaeological and backhoe testing, to eliminate incompatible sites
- 2) Look for existing systems that could be expanded with private landowners - possibly using pre-treatment. If there is town land that is near a private well, consider moving the location of the well, to make the town land a possibility.
- 3) Focus on town-owned land
- 4) Ask the community: Ask property owners to see if anyone would volunteer their land for a site

John Reilly's notes:

Hello Davis,

I was out of the office last week. I am not aware of a need to join the Village Support WID Open Office Hours. My notes from the 6/27 meeting follow:

1. Archeology Test Pits are required.
2. Investigations should include hand auger use if possible for elimination of sites.
3. Consider expansion of existing WW systems if possible
4. The bullet point SOW is generally acceptable
5. Send ESA Amendment to ANR Portal and Lynnette because this is Village WW
6. Consider Town owned land

7. Town should see if there are property owner volunteers willing to sell disposal area land
8. ESA Amendment require about a 2 week review time by WID
9. No EPA grant funding is available next SFY due to WID staffing limitations. May be available in future years
10. Greensboro WW Committee requested HT to draft ESA Amendment to continue WW planning with remaining unused budget

Hoyle Tanner will draft an ESA Amendment to continue Village WW planning with the remaining unused budget.
